THE BURDEN

"Exhausted yet pursuing." Judges 8:4.

This is a simple summary of life and ministry these days.

Ministry is exhausting, but the pursuit never ends. God and His mission never ends. And as long as he gives us strength we will use it, after all, the life is His.

Exhausted by **"Ephraimitic syndrome"** of why have you treated us like this? Why didn't you call us?

Exhausted by sharp criticism and resentment from brethren in the midst of pursuit of the Great Commission in the face of insecurities, kidnappings and killings. The mind is full of sorrow and torment.

Sorrow (Lk 21: 45-46) and the sinful lives of men around us can also be exhausting (2 Pt 2:7-9)

Meager resources can be exhausting but limited resources never limit God. We face a lot of discouragement from within and without but discouragement can delay but should never be allowed to halt God's ultimate plan for victory.

We shall press on, so, friends, let's Press on.

During this convention, issues that exhaust in the pursuit of the Great Commission, and what we are to do, shall be looked into.

We shall be receiving encouragement, healing and grace to press on.

BRING ME NEW CRUSE 2 KINGS 2:19-22

And the men of the city said unto Elisha, Behold, I pray thee, **the situation of this city is pleasant, as my Lord seeth: but the water is naught, and the ground barren (cause to miscarry).**

NIV says

"Look, our Lord, this town is well situated, as you can see, but the water is bad and the land is unproductive."

And he said, **bring me a new cruse (bowl)**, and **put salt therein**. And they brought it to him. And he went forth unto the spring of the waters, and cast the salt in there, and said, **thus saith the Lord**, I have healed these waters; there shall not be from thence any more death or barren land. So the waters were healed unto this day, according to the saying of Elisha which he spake.

Description of their present/current situations:

Town well located, but the water is BAD. Town well-situated, but the land is unproductive

Note

The men of city were the ones that took their situation, the situation of their city to the LORD. They said

"Look, our Lord, this town is well situated, as you can see, but the water is bad and the land is unproductive."

The men were sincere with their Diagnosis. They called a "spade a spade"

God's Intervention

Began with an instruction to the men: "Bring me a. NEW bowl. Put <u>SALT</u> in it.

The men obeyed and carried out the instruction. "So they brought it to Him.

Then came the solution:

"I have healed this water. Never again will it cause death or make the land unproductive.

The testimony was that:

"And the water has remained wholesome to this day according to the word Elisha has spoken"

By the time we are rounding up this meeting on Friday night, this TESTIMONY is what we want to have.

But we are starting the journey to our testimony TODAY.

Men and women from among us shall be standing on this altar to lead us to God in the place of prayer:

- i. To jointly present our various present situations to God.
- ii. To jointly present the present situations of our fields, zones or office to God.
- iii. To present the situations of our marriages and homes to God.
- iv. To present the situation of the unreached people to God
- v. To present the situation of Nigeria and other countries of the world to God.

As individuals, we must make up our minds not to hide anything to the Lord who sees and knows everything. We must not pretend or hide our whitlow. We must say it as it is to the Lord.

This demand for individuals seeking God's face personally and confessing our situation to God, and expecting to have a testimony of healing in our individual situation.

The instruction is "bring me a **NEW** bowl. Put **SALT** in it"

<u>A new cruse</u>

A demand for an instrument uncontaminated by use, wholly clean and pure. Salt is an antiseptic, a medium to expel the corruption of the water. Salt symbolizes permanence, loyalty, durability, fidelity, usefulness, value, purification.

BIBLE STUDY

Topic:

BE CAREFUL OF "BANANA PEELS" AS YOU LEAD MEN IN GOD'S WILL



INTRODUCTION:

B anana peels or skin is the outermost layer of banana fruit. The peel is slippery when stepped on, and capable of making a man to fall. It could be noticed, but underestimated or unnoticed before a man step on it. Banana peels are figuration of things that could make a man fall as he leads people in God's will.

As missionaries and leaders at all level labouring for the Kingdom of God, we are often confronted with different issues, which if not handled properly might lead to our downfall and/or cause chaos in God's work committed into our hands. These issues are referred to as "External Banana peels".

Aside the "external banana peels" there are internal issues in a man's life that might not be obvious (easily seen). These are referred to as "Internal Banana Peels", which if not taken care of, could drain God's grace, anointing and investment in one's life and slip him off divine allotment in His vineyard.

These peels (external and internal) are capable of getting us as missionaries exhausted as we pursue fulfilling the Great Commission.

Our concern in this study would be to identify banana peels on our paths as we lead men in God's will, through careful study of the lives of Gideon, Jephthah and other Bible characters and cry unto God in prayers to help our lives, so that we can run the race set before us and finish strong.

EXTERNAL BANANA PEELS Teaching Method

A. Role Play:

A town crier announces that everyone should come out tomorrow morning for town hall building project. People came out with their working tools. Some were helping the masons by carrying blocks, packing of sand while some were fetching water. But Sule and his friend, Uche leave for farm. Later in the evening when they return, they complain that the work was not properly done.

INTRODUCTION :

Ces peaux de bananes (externes et internes) sont capables de nous fatiguer en tant que des missionnaires, dans notre poursuite de l'accomplissement de la Grande Commission. Pour notre étude ici, nous allons identifier ces peaux de bananes sur notre piste tandis que nous dirigeons les hommes dans la volonté de Dieu, au travers d'une étude minutieuse de la vie de Gédéon, de Jephté et d'autres personnages de la Bible, et crier à Dieu en prières afin qu'il nous aide, afin que nous puissions courir dans la carrière qui nous est ouverte, et bien la terminer.

YOUTH BIBLE STUDY

Topic: BE CAREFUL OF "BANANA PEELS" ON YOUR LIFE'S JOURNEY

magine a young man who is well dressed in an immaculate white suit going for a scholarship interview. As he was called to go into the room to meet the examiners, he picked up his briefcase and swoosh! He finds himself slipping and falling down with nothing to hang on to, he falls and hits the waste paper basket which turns its contents on him. By the time he gets up, his white dress is already stained. He wonders what made him fall, he looks around only to find a banana peel on the floor. An ordinary banana peel ruined his whole day. It could even make him fail the interview because his confidence is already shaken and his dress is stained, giving the impression that he is a dirty and lousy fellow. Banana peels can easily be overlooked, but if not handled properly can be a great tool in the hand of the devil to bring a man down.

As a youth who has a desire to follow Christ, you need to watch out for what we call banana peels in a man's life. These are seemingly little things that we all have the tendency to ignore, but if they are not dealt with on time, they will wait for the day when you have risen to a level of honour, then it will surface and it has the potential to bring you down. In this study, we shall try to identify what can be referred to as banana peels in a young person's life and how we should deal with them in order to secure our future. We will be checking the scriptures together.

A. First banana peel- Lost or wrong identity

Who are you? We all have answers to that question. But, what you think about yourself may be different from what God sees about you. Sometimes we misunderstand our identities. The case of the wrong identity can be seen with Simon Peter. He had always identified himself as Simon (unstable reed). But, Jesus revealed the true identity that God has ordained for him and changed his name to Peter (a rock). (Matthew 16:16-19) Judges 6:11-18

- In what way did Gideon misunderstand his identity?

- If someone misunderstands his identity, how is he likely to behave towards his life's mission or assignment?

Jesus knew his identity (Hebrews 10: 7, Psalms 40:7).

- What is your identity as a child of God? (John 1:12, John 3:3).
- God has an assignment or mission for every life. Have you discovered yours?(Jeremiah 1:5)

- What are the signs of a person who has a wrong identity?(Psalms 49:12,20). You cannot have a true identity until you have given the lordship of your life to Jesus Christ. (John 3:3,6 ; 1 Corinthians 2:9-12).

B. Second banana peel - Lust or idols in the heart.

(Read Judges 8:22-27; 9:1-2).

- What is lust?(James 1:13-14)
- What are the dangers of having lust in the heart? (2 Peter 1:4; 1John 2:15-17; Matthew 5:28, Mark 4:19, Romans 1:27, 1 John 6:12, 2Timothy 2:22)
- What examples of lust can we find among young people nowadays?

C. Third banana peel – hypocrisy or not owning up.

- What is hypocrisy?
- Why do people cover-up? (Acts 1-5)
- What are the dangers of hypocrisy? (Job 8:13; Job 13:16; Job 15:34; Job 20:5; Job 27:8; Job 36:13).

D. <u>Removing the banana peels</u>

- Ask God to search your heart and reveal the true condition of your life to you. (Psalms 139:23-24)
- Recognize the banana peels that are present in your life. Admit your fault (2Samuel 12:13; Psalms 51:1-4)
- Cry out to God for help. (Psalms 3:4, , Romans 10:13)
- The place of counselling (Proverbs 11:14; Proverbs 12:15; Proverbs 15:22, 19:20; 24:6).

Conclusion:

he plans that God has for you as a young person are good plans and not evil plans to give you a sure future (Jeremiah 29:11). The banana peels are snares set by the devil to entangle you. But as you get rid of these peels with the help of God, nothing will be able to stop you from attaining God's goals for your life. Removal of the banana peels is not an end in itself. It is to enhance you to arise and fulfil God's destiny for your life. The nations are waiting for you as they waited for Gideon, so arise, be an instrument in God's hands to deliver your generation.
